"The Home Service" is a weekly programme, which has broadcast on 10radio, your local community radio station, for over 4 years. It aims to bring Christian worship into people's front rooms.

Live broadcasts on 105.3FM (and streaming on the internet at 10radio.org) usually take place on Wednesdays at 11.00 a.m., repeated at 10.00 a.m. on a Sunday, and consist of a 30 minute act of worship led by a local Christian minister or church/worship leader. In addition, there is an opportunity for news and information about what is happening in our churches to be shared and listen to local people sharing their spiritual and life journeys. The programme is also available throughout the week on 10Radio's 'Listen again' facility at 10Radio.org.

The Home Service is being relaunched on Wednesday 27th November in anticipation of the Advent season and the lead up to Christmas.
