## Giftng to St John's Church

Did you know that a financial gift to the church can be enhanced by 25% through Gift Aid? The scheme of Planned Giving enables your monthly total to be increased by a further 25% if you are a taxpayer. Pensions can bring the individual into arena of tax paying.

On occasions where an individual wishes to gift an item that the church needs, then the most financially advantageous way is to gift the cost of purchase to St John's bank account and ask for the money to ring-fenced to buying that item. Later, the church, having charity status, can claim 25% of the sum via the government gift aid scheme as **extra** to the total already donated by the generous donor.

## Blackdowns Early Music Concert

St John's will be hosting Blackdowns Early Music Projects for their concert, ***Laudate Dominum*** on **Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> August** at 7.30 p.m.

The programme is based around the predictions of the twelve ancient Seers or Sybils and translated into extraordinary music by Orlando di Lasso in *Prophetiae Sybillarum*. There is also a double choir Motet and a so-called parody Mass by Giovanni P. di Palestrina, and a triple choir Motet by Melchior Vulpius. The Voices are variously accompanied by a choir of four sackbuts and organ continuo, all directed by JanJoost van Elburg.
