St John's plays host to Somerset County Young Musicians

On Tuesday 23rd July 7.30 p.m. St John's Church will be the setting for a concert by the Somerset County Youth Orchestra under their conductor, Andrew Sherwood. The programme will include music composed by the Milverton Primary School pupil Elliot Coles. Elliott's composition, 'Galactic Procession', was written as part of an initiative called 'On the Record' run by Actiontrack Performance Company in partnership with the county music education hub.

In another first for the orchestra, conductor Andrew Sherwood will pass the baton to Louis Bennyworth, a senior orchestra member. Louis' debut as conductor will see him directing a performance of Max Bruch's popular 'Violin Concerto No. 1' in which Andrew Sherwood, a violin professor at the Trinity-Laban College of Music, London will be the soloist. The evening will also include Aaron Copland's ballet score for 'Appalachian Spring', Leonard Bernstein's jazz-infused 'Overture to Candide', and 'Pluto's Song', written by Wellington composer Julian Breeze.

The next evening, Wednesday 24th July at 7.00 p.m. the Somerset Youth Concert Band will perform a wide-ranging mixture of pieces in varying musical styles – a programme to suit every taste!

Admission prices are the same for each concert, £11 and Concessions for Students & Under 16s at £9. They are bookable in advance although there will be admission at the door.
