### The Archdeacon's Visit to the Benefice 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> June

On Pentecost Sunday (8<sup>th</sup> June), Holy Communion will be at <u>**10.30 a.m**</u>. One reason for the later service time is that we can follow the service with a Bring-and-Share lunch in the Hall with Archdeacon Simon. It is proposed that a service of Evensong will take place at St Mary the Virgin on Monday, 9<sup>th</sup> June. During the two days of the Archdeacon's visit, he will meet separately with Reverend Colin, the churchwardens, members of the joint PCC, the Safeguarding Officer, with younger people and those of working age, visit St John's School, and meet others of the wider ministry team.
