It costs over £2000 a week to keep the doors open, and we are very grateful to everyone who volunteers, bakes, donates, and supports these events. Updates on Various Projects

- 1. Our search for a reasonable quotation for clearing the church roof twice a year is proving to be a frustrating task for several reasons. Those quotes we have received vary enormously.
- 2. The electrical survey required to be carried out every five years has been done, and a new certificate issued. The electrics of St John's is to be a major consideration in our maintenance and refurbishment thinking, leading to improved lighting, a new heating system, and a zero-carbon future.
- 3. The organ maintenance and improvements: we have taken the decision to install a working processor, the old one having stopped several years ago. A processor allows the organist to select the ranks of pipes to suit the music. The processor should be in place at some point in the next few weeks.
- 4. Quotations for the refurbishment of the rear door, allowing for easier access for mobility users, have been obtained, and a decision will be taken imminently. Meanwhile, Richard Elloway continues his sterling efforts in his swimathon, and with your support, to raise funds for the work to proceed.

Richard Elloway's Swimathon Update

Richard Elloway is completing a sponsored swim to raise several thousand pounds towards the refurbishment of the rear door used by people with mobility issues. He aims to swim 45 miles, about 2500 lengths in the Wellington Sports Centre pool. He is now over the halfway mark in his swim!
